Product Overview	Recombinant human PCYT2 protein, fused to His-tag at N-terminus, was expressed in E.coli and purified by using conventional chromatography.

Description	PCYT2 is an enzyme that catalyzes the formation of CDP-ethanolamine from CTP and phosphoethanolamine in the Kennedy pathway of phospholipid synthesis. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants.
Form	Liquid. In 20mM Tris-HCl buffer (pH 8.0) containing 20% glycerol, 0.1M NaCl, 1mM DTT, 0.1mM PMSF.
Molecular Weight	45.9 kDa (409aa), confirmed by MALDI-TOF.
Purity	>90% by SDS-PAGE
Concentration	0.25 mg/ml (determined by Bradford assay)
