Product Overview	Recombinant human CST6 protein, fused to His-tag at N-terminus, was expressed in E. coli and purified by using conventional chromatography techniques.

Description	CST6 is a member of the type 2 cystatin family. Some of the members are active cysteine protease inhibitors, while cystatin E/M moderate the inhibition of cathepsin B but is not active against cathepsin C. CST6 is a secretable protein that influences osteogenesis and bone resorption, regulation of the insulin and hepatocyte growth factor receptors, and the response to systemic inflammation.

Form	Supplied as a liquid in 20mM Tris-HCl buffer, pH 8.0, containing 10% glycerol, 1mM DTT and 0.1M NaCl.

Storage	Store at 4 deg C for short term storage (1/2 weeks). Aliquot and store at -20 deg C or - 70 deg C for long term storage. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.
