Product Overview	Recombinant IL10 protein, fused to His-tag at N-terminus, was expressed in E. coli and was purified by conventional chromatography techniques.

Description	Interleukin-10 (IL 10) is also known as human cytokine synthesis inhibitory factor (CSIF) and inhibits the synthesis of pro-inflammatory cytokines like IFN-gamma, IL2, IL3, TNF and GM-CSF produced by activated macrophages and by helper T-cells. This protein has effects in immunoregulation and inflammation and down-regulates the expression of Th1 cytokines, MHC class II proteins, and costimulatory molecules on macrophages.

Applications	SDS-PAGE
Endotoxin Levels	< 1.0 EU per ug of protein (determined by LAL method)
Storage	Store at 4 deg C for short term storage (1/2 weeks). Aliquot and store at -20 deg C or - 70 deg C for long term storage. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.

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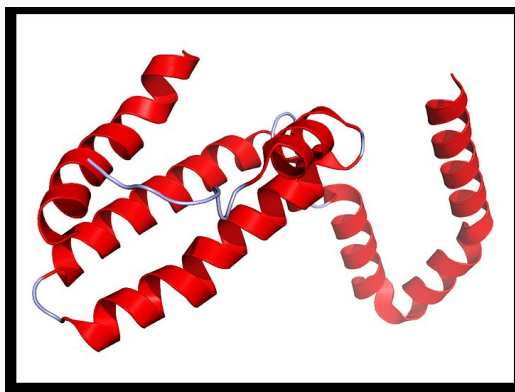
