Product Overview	Recombinant human IL28A was expressed in E. coli and purified by using conventional chromatography techniques.

Description	IFN-lambda-1, -2, and -3 (also known as IL29, IL28A and IL28B respectively) are distantly related to the IL10 family and Interferons. All three IFN-lambdas uses a distinct receptor system composed of an IFN-lambdaR1 subunit (also called CRF2-12) and IL10R2 subunit (also called CRF2-14). Signaling through this receptor system induces antiviral defense similar but distinct than the type I Interferons.

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Applications	Numerous applications are possible with this product and should be tested by the end user under their own laboratory conditions
Endotoxin Levels	Endotoxin level is less than 0.1 ng per ug (1 EU/ug).
Bioactivity	Determined by its ability to activate STAT following receptor-ligand interaction.
Storage	Store at 4 deg C until reconstitution. Following reconstitution aliquot and freeze at -20 deg C for long term storage. Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles.
