Product Overview	Recombinant Human c-erbB2 Protein (537-636aa), was expressed in E.coli without tag (purified via proprietary chromatographic techniques).

Description	c-erbB-2 is a receptor tyrosine kinase of the c-erbB family. It is closely related in structure to the epidermal growth factor receptor. c-erbB-2 oncoprotein is detectable in a proportion of breast and other adenocarcinomas, as well as transitional cell carcinomas. In the case of breast cancer, expression determined by immunohistochemistry has been shown to be associated with poor prognosis.

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Characterization	On SDS-PAGE commassie blue stained gel, the purified recombinant protein shows a band at 37 kDa.
Storage	Store vial at -20°C to -80°C. When stored at the recommended temperature, this protein is stable for 12 months. Please avoid freeze-thaw cycles.
