Product Overview	Recombinant full length Active Caspase 6 protein (Human)
Species	Human
Description	This gene encodes a protein which is a member of the cysteine-aspartic acid protease (caspase) family. Sequential activation of caspases plays a central role in the execution-phase of cell apoptosis. Caspases exist as inactive proenzymes which undergo proteolytic processing at conserved aspartic residues to produce two subunits, large and small, that dimerize to form the active enzyme. This protein is processed by caspases 7, 8 and 10, and is thought to function as a downstream enzyme in the caspase activation cascade. Alternative splicing of this gene results in two transcript variants that encode different isoforms.
Biological activity	SPECIFIC ACTIVITY: 13,000 units/mg
Form	Lyophilised:Reconstitute to 1 unit per µl in PBS containing 15% glycerol. Following reconstitution in PBS, the enzyme should be aliquoted and immediately stored at -80°C.
Purity	>95% by SDS-PAGE
Storage buffer	Preservative: NoneConstituents: 15% Glycerol, PBS
Storage	Aliquot and store at -80°C. Avoid repeated freeze / thaw cycles.
