Product Overview	Recombinant full length MCP2 protein , is a non-glycosylated, polypeptide chain containing 76 amino acids and has a MW of 8.9 kDa.

Description	This gene is one of several cytokine genes clustered on the q-arm of chromosome 17. Cytokines are a family of secreted proteins involved in immunoregulatory and inflammatory processes. The protein encoded by this gene is structurally related to the CXC subfamily of cytokines. Members of this subfamily are characterized by two cysteines separated by a single amino acid. This cytokine displays chemotactic activity for monocytes, lymphocytes, basophils and eosinophils. By recruiting leukocytes to sites of inflammation this cytokine may contribute to tumor-associated leukocyte infiltration and to the antiviral state against HIV infection.
Biological activity	The biological activity was determined by measuring the dose dependent mobilization of intracellular calcium (calcium flux) with human THP-1 cells. Significant calcium mobilization is observed with >500ng/mL of recombinant human MCP2. Human MCP2 also indu
Form	Lyophilised:Lyophilized from a concentrated (1mg/ml) sterile solution containing no additives. Reconstitute the lyophilized product in sterile 18MO-cm H2O not less than 100µg/ml, which can then be further diluted to other aqueous solutions.
