Product Overview	Recombinant rat CRP, fused to His-tag at C-terminus, was expressed in insect cell and purified by using conventional chromatography techniques.

Description	CRP, also known as c-reactive protein, displays several functions associated with host defense. It promotes agglutination, bacterial capsular swelling, phagocytosis and complement fixation through its calcium-dependent binding to phosphorylcholine and can interact with DNA and histones and may scavenge nuclear material released from damaged circulating cells.
Form	Liquid. In Phosphate Buffered Saline (pH 7.4) containing 10% glycerol.
