Description	D-gluconate kinase, thermosensitive, also known as idnk, D-gluconate kinase, thermosensitive, also known as idnk, is a 187 amino acid protein that belongs to the gluconokinase gntK/gntV family and catalyzes the conversion of ATP and D-gluconate to ADP and 6-phospho-D-gluconate. This protein is thought to play a role in gender determination, deletion of the distal portion of 9p can lead to development of male to female sex reversal, the phenotype of a female with a male X, Y genotype.
Form	Liquid. In 20mM Tris-HCl buffer (pH 8.0) containing 0.15M NaCl, 10% glycerol, 1mM DTT
Bio-activity	Specific activity is >80 units/mg, in which one unit will convert 1.0 umole of D-gluconate to 6-phospho-D-gluconate per minute at pH 8.0 at 37C.
