Product Overview	Recombinant full length Hsp70 cloned from a human cDNA library and expressed in Hi5 cells using baculovirus expression.
Species	Human
Description	This intronless gene encodes a 70kDa heat shock protein which is a member of the heat shock protein 70 family. In conjunction with other heat shock proteins, this protein stabilizes existing proteins against aggregation and mediates the folding of newly translated proteins in the cytosol and in organelles. It is also involved in the ubiquitin-proteasome pathway through interaction with the AU-rich element RNA-binding protein 1. The gene is located in the major histocompatibility complex class III region, in a cluster with two closely related genes which encode similar proteins.
Tissue specificity	HSPA1B is testis-specific.
Biological activity	HSPA1B-29401TH tested positive for ATPase activity using a Malachite Green assay.
