Description	The proliferation and differentiation of B cells is dependent upon a B-cell antigen receptor (BCR) complex. Binding of antigens to specific B-cell receptors results in a tyrosine phosphorylation reaction through the BCR complex and leads to multiple signal transduction pathways.

Storage	Shipped at 4°C. Upon delivery aliquot and store at -80oC. Avoid freeze / thaw cycles.
