Product Overview	Recombinant fragment, corresponding to amino acids 500-756 of Human LOXL4 expressed in a baculovirus-infected Sf9 cell expression system; 257 amino acids, MWt 31kDa.

Description	This gene encodes a member of the lysyl oxidase gene family. The prototypic member of the family is essential to the biogenesis of connective tissue, encoding an extracellular copper-dependent amine oxidase that catalyses the first step in the formation of crosslinks in collagens and elastin. A highly conserved amino acid sequence at the C-terminus end appears to be sufficient for amine oxidase activity, suggesting that each family member may retain this function. The N-terminus is poorly conserved and may impart additional roles in developmental regulation, senescence, tumor suppression, cell growth control, and chemotaxis to each member of the family.

Storage buffer	Preservative: None Constituents: 20% Glycerol, 0.05% Tween 20, 3mM DTT, 25mM Tris HCl, 100mM Sodium chloride, pH 8.0
Storage	Aliquot and store at -80°C. Avoid repeated freeze / thaw cycles.
