Product Overview	Recombinant human RAB27A, fused to His-tag at N-terminus, was expressed in <i>E.coli</i> and purified by using conventional chromatography techniques. MW = 27 kDa (241aa).

Description	Ras-related protein Rab-27A, also known as RAB27A, belongs to the small GTPase superfamily, Rab family. The protein is membrane-bound and may be involved in protein transport and small GTPase mediated signal transduction. Also, RAB27A regulates the cytotoxic granule exocytosis and affect T-lymphocyte and macrophage-activation. It is widely expressed with significant expression in pancreatic islets and pituitary tissue, and low expression in brain. Defects in RAB27A cause Griscelli syndrome type 2 (GS2).
Form	Liquid. In 20mM Tris-HCl buffer (pH 8.0) containing 1mM DTT, 20% glycerol.
Purity	> 90% by SDS – PAGE.
Concentration	1 mg/ml (determined by Bradford assay).
