Product Overview	Recombinant Influenza A virus (A/Moscow/10/1999(H3N2)) hemagglutinin (ABE73115.1) (Met1-Trp530), termed as HA, was expressed with a polyhistidine tag at the C-terminus.

Source	Insect Cells
ProteinLength	1-530 a.a.
Predicted N Terminal	Gln 17
Form	Lyophilized from sterile 20 mM Tris, 500 mM NaCl, 10 % glycerol, pH 7.0, 5%~8% trehalose and mannitol.
Bio-activity	Measured by its ability to agglutinate guinea pig red blood cells. HA titer is 0.02-0.1µg/mL for 1% GRBC.
Molecular Mass	The recombinant hemagglutinin of Influenza A virus (A/Moscow/10/1999(H3N2)) consists 525 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 59.3 kDa.
Endotoxin	< 1.0 EU per µg of the protein as determined by the LAL method.
Purity	>95 % as determined by SDS-PAGE.

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Stability	Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -70°C.
Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C~-70°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.25 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.

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
