Product Overview	Recombinant canine CD3E (NP_001003379.1) (Met1-Leu122) was expressed with the Fc region of human IgG1 at the C-terminus.
Species	Canine

Predicted N Terminal	Gln 22
Form	Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4, 5%~8% trehalose and mannitol.
Molecular Mass	The recombinant canine CD3E consists 339 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 38.2 kDa.
Endotoxin	< 1.0 EU per µg of the protein as determined by the LAL method.
Purity	>85 % as determined by SDS-PAGE.
Stability	Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -70°C.
Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C~-70°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

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Reconstitution

It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.25 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
