Description	Chlamydia is a common term for infection with any bacterium belonging to the phylum Chlamydiae. This term derives from the name of the bacterial genus Chlamydia in the family Chlamydiaceae, order Chlamydiales, class and phylum Chlamydiae. There are two genera in Chlamydiaceae: Chlamydia and Chlamydophila. The genus Chlamydia includes three species: C. trachomatis, C. muridarum, and C. suis.
Form	20mM Tris-HCl, pH 7.2, 50% glycerol and 1.5M urea.
Purity	Protein is >90% pure as determined by SDS-PAGE.
Applications	Elisa, WB and Flow-Through.
Usage	The products are furnished for LABORATORY RESEARCH USE ONLY. The product may not be used as drugs, agricultural or pesticidal products, food additives or household chemicals.

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Specificity	Immunoreactive with sera of Chlamydia Trachomatis infected individuals with minimum specificity problems.
Storage	Chlamydia W2 protein although stable at 4°C for 1 week, should be stored below -18°C. Please prevent freeze thaw cycles.
