SPECIFICATION

Product Overview	Recombinant HCV Core produced in E.coli is a non-glycosylated polypeptide chain having a molecular mass of 16.8kDa and fused to a His tag at N-terminus.

Description	HCV is a small 50nm, enveloped, single-stranded, positive sense RNAvirus in the family Flaviviridae. HCV has a high rate of replication with approximately one trillion particles produced each day in an infected individual. Due to lack of proofreading by the HCV RNA polymerase, the HCV has an exceptionally high mutation rate, a factor that may help it elude the host's immune response. Hepatitis C virus is classified into six genotypes(1-6) with several subtypes within each genotype. The preponderance and distribution of HCV genotypes varies globally. Genotype is clinically important in determining potential response to interferon-based therapy and the required duration of such therapy. Genotypes 1 and 4 are less responsive to interferon-based treatment than are the other genotypes (2, 3, 5 and 6).
Form	Sterile Filtered White lyophilized (freeze-dried) powder. Lyophilized from 1mg/ml in 1x PBS pH-7.4 and 0.05% SDS.

Purity	Greater than 95.0% as determined by SDS-PAGE.

Stability	HCV Core although stable at room temperature for 4 weeks, should be stored below - 18°C. Please prevent freeze thaw cycles.
Solubility	It is recommended to reconstitute the lyophilized HCV Core in sterile 18M-cm H2O not less than 100g/ml, which can then be further diluted to other aqueous solutions.
