Product Overview	Recombinant protein of human X-ray repair complementing defective repair in Chinese hamster cells 4 (XRCC4), transcript variant 1 was expressed in human HEK293 cells.

Description	The protein encoded by this gene functions together with DNA ligase IV and the DNA-dependent protein kinase in the repair of DNA double-strand breaks. This protein plays a role in both non-homologous end joining and the completion of V(D)J recombination. Mutations in this gene can cause short stature, microcephaly, and endocrine dysfunction (SSMED). Alternative splicing generates several transcript variants.
