Description	PDGFR α (platelet-derived growth factor receptor α) is a member of the PDGFR family of membrane receptors with intrinsic tyrosine kinase activity. Aberrant expression of PDGFR α has been linked to developmental abnormalities in vertebrate models and has been implicated in multiple disease states in humans. There is widespread expression of PDGFR α in renal cell types involved in fibrotic and sclerosing processes. PDGF and its receptor PDGFR α are inducers of fibrosis in the repair phase of inflammatory bowel disease and they may also be involved in the active inflammatory phase. PDGFR α (T674I) is one of the mutant forms of PDGFR α .
