Description	PLD3 belongs to the phospholipase D family. It contains two PLD phosphodiesterase domains. PLD3 is widely expressed; expressed at higher level in brain; low level in corpus callosum, suggesting that it is highly expressed in neurons. PLD3 has a post-translational modification, it is glycosylated.

Form	Lyophilised:Reconstitution with 56 µl aqua dest.
Storage buffer	Preservative: NoneConstituents: 0.5% Trehalose, 6M Urea, 100mM Sodium phosphate, 10mM Sodium chloride, pH 4.5
