Product Overview	Recombinant fragment of human Plasminogen kringle 1 + 2 + 3; 259 amino acids, 30.0 kDa.

Description	The protein encoded by this gene is a secreted blood zymogen that is activated by proteolysis and converted to plasmin and angiostatin. Plasmin dissolves fibrin in blood clots and is an important protease in many other cellular processes while angiostatin inhibits angiogenesis. Defects in this gene are likely a cause of thrombophilia and ligenous conjunctivitis. Two transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been found for this gene.
Form	Lyophilised:Reconstitute in sterile distilled water or aqueous buffer containing 0.1% BSA to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/ml.
Purity	>95% by SDS-PAGE
Storage buffer	Preservative: NoneConstituents: 4% Mannitol, 20mM Sodium acetate, pH 5.5
Storage	Aliquot and store at -80°C (add 1% BSA for extra stability). Avoid repeated freeze / thaw cycles.
