Description	This gene was identified as a gene whose expression can be induced by the tumor necrosis factor alpha (TNF) in umbilical vein endothelial cells. Studies of a similar gene in mouse suggest that the expression of this gene is developmentally regulated in a tissue-specific manner.
Form	50 mM Tris-HCl, 10 mM reduced Glutathione, pH=8.0 in the elution buffer.
