Product Overview	This product is the Biotinylated Ricinus Communis Agglutinin I and has sugar specificity against galactose and lactose.

Source	Ricinus Communis
Description	This lectin consists of two subunits of 60 kDa which can be dissociated by reducing agents into closely related chains between 27 kDa and 33 kDa. One of the chains appears to be common to the “B” chain of another castor bean lectin, ricin, while the other chain is unique to RCA I. The B chain binds to galactose or N-acetylgalactosamine residues of membrane glycoconjugates.
Form	10 mM phosphate, 0.15 M NaCl, pH 7.5, 0.08% sodium azide.
Bio-activity	Inhibiting/Eluting Sugar: 200 mM galactose or lactose Carbohydrate-Binding Specificity: Galactose, Lactose.
