Product Overview	Recombinant Human SPIC fused with His tag at N-termina was expressed in E. coli.

Description	The protein encoded by this gene regulates the development of red pulp macrophages, which are necessary for iron homeostasis and the recycling of red blood cells.
Form	25mM Tris, pH 8.0, 150 mM NaCl, 10% glycerol, 1% Sarkosyl. Store at -80 centigrad e. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. Stable for at least 3 months from receipt of products under proper storage and handling conditions.
Molecular Mass	29.2 kDa
Purity	> 80% as determined by SDS-PAGE and Coomassie blue staining
Concentration	>50 ug/mL as determined by microplate BCA method
