Product Overview	Recombinant Human RARA(154-462) was expressed in E.coli. The His-tag recombinant protein is purified by affinity chromatography in combination with FPLC columns. The purified RAR-alpha-LBD is greater than 95% homogeneous based on SDS-PAGE analysis.

Description	This gene represents a nuclear retinoic acid receptor. The encoded protein, retinoic acid receptor alpha, regulates transcription in a ligand-dependent manner. This gene has been implicated in regulation of development, differentiation, apoptosis, granulopoiesis, and transcription of clock genes. Translocations between this locus and several other loci have been associated with acute promyelocytic leukemia. Alternatively spliced transcript variants have been found for this locus.
Form	The protein is in 20mM Tris-HCl pH7.9, 100mM NaCl, 0.2mM EDTA, 1mM DTT and 20% glycerol.

Unit Definition

1 unit equals 1 nanogram of purified protein. 20 unit is sufficient for a gel mobility shift assay; 100 units are sufficient for protein-protein interaction assays.

RAR α can be applied in in vitro transcription assays, DNA-protein and protein-protein interaction assays.

Stored at -70°C before use. Avoid repeated freeze thaw cycles.
