Product Overview	Recombinant full length Rsk 2 / MAPKAP Kinase 1b protein (Human), was expressed by baculovirus in Sf9 insect cells using a N-terminal tag, MW 112 kDa.
Species	Human
Description	This gene encodes a member of the RSK (ribosomal S6 kinase) family of serine/threonine kinases. This kinase contains 2 non-identical kinase catalytic domains and phosphorylates various substrates, including members of the mitogen-activated kinase (MAPK) signalling pathway. The activity of this protein has been implicated in controlling cell growth and differentiation. Mutations in this gene have been associated with Coffin-Lowry syndrome (CLS).
